Narrawong District Primary School Uniform

Prepared in 2019 for use in 2020 and beyond

Please make sure your child attends school wearing correct school uniform, as outlined below.

School logo items are available to purchase new from the school office. From 2020 the school will also host a second hand uniform exchange – where parents can offer up items 'free to a good home' or for purchase as reasonable second-hand pricing. More details available in early 2020 – keep an eye on the skoolbag app and school Facebook page.

In 2020 we will provide a phase-out period for items previously considered (including informally) part of the school uniform, but which will no longer be considered uniform for 2021. These include:

- Tartan winter dresses still in use by a small number of families in the school
- Polo shirts bearing the school logo but custom made by a different supplier in a different shade (a more bluish tone) to the school jade green.
- Custom made Rugby style tops with the school logo embroidered on them
- Plain navy jumpers, hoodies, cardigans, jackets and hats (that do not bear the school logo).

School tops and bottoms

School Logo Jade Polo Shirt - purchased from the school (note that the official school shirt has a navy stripe on the collar and is jade green rather than a slightly turquoise colour).

Sizes 4-16 Approx: \$26

Long sleeved polo shirts will be available in 2020 as well.

In cold weather the shirt can be layered over a long sleeved navy t-shirt.



The school shirt can be teamed with <u>plain navy</u> bottoms in a range of options including: tracksuit pants, long pants/trousers, leggings, shorts, or skorts. You have flexibility to choose items to suit your child's preferences and the weather conditions. Other colours, and items with obvious branding etc., are not school uniform.

These items can purchased from a range of clothing suppliers that stock standard school uniform items.
